New Christian Children's Book Celebrates Social Gospel Understanding of Jesus and the Easter Story

Rev. Paul Brandeis Raushenbush releases Together We Rise: An Easter Story for All Of Us

NEW YORK – Two years ago, Rev. Paul Brandeis Raushenbush was searching for a Christian children's book that would tell the story of Easter in a way that represented his own understanding of Jesus and the meaning of Jesus' life, his crucifixion and his resurrection. As Raushenbush writes in the introduction: "I lamented, as Holy Week rapidly arrived, that I didn't have a children's story of Jesus that reflected my beliefs that I could share with my two sons and their young minds, hearts and spirits. So, I boiled down two thousand years of theology and almost three decades of ministry to the words you are about to read."

Raushenbush put the story on social media and the response was overwhelming. And so he teamed up with production designer Tim Gilman and illustrator Jin Xia to create *Together We Rise: An Easter Story for All of Us.* The book intentionally showcases a diversity of sizes and shapes and colors of humanity featuring a Black Jesus, who in the story is described as "God's heart in human form who came to show a different kind of power to the world, the power of Love."

"I trained in theology at Union Seminary and am indebted to liberation theologies as well as my great-grandfather Walter Rauschenbusch's contribution through the Social Gospel," remarked Raushenbush. "My hope is that young people will learn the radical message of love and liberation that Jesus brought to the world, especially in this time when too many are using Jesus and Christianity as a bludgeon and a screen for bigotry and hate."



About the author:

Rev. Paul Brandeis Raushenbush is an ordained American Baptist minister who has served in churches across the country including the historic Riverside Church in New York City. He was Associate Dean of Religious Life and the Chapel at Princeton University and held senior positions at Interfaith America and Auburn Theological Seminary. He was an editor at Beliefnet where he had an advice column called Ask Pastor Paul, which led to the book *Teen Spirit*.

Raushenbush was the founder of HuffPost Religion which was the largest religion website for four years and for which he received a Webby. Raushenbush is the great-grandson of Walter Rauschenbuch, who was the main figure in the Social Gospel in the beginning of the 20th Century and in whose tradition he continues to walk. He is from and interfaith family, with another great-grandfather being Louis D. Brandeis, and he currently serves as President and CEO of Interfaith Alliance.
